Solid silver serving spoonsilversmith Jean Redard, active from 1724 to 1766 [Junier Clerc & Krenz, p.71 no. MAH 75] Switzerland, Neuchâtel, circa 1740----- L 30.5 W 153 g -----A beautiful, heavy-quality pattern with a tapered bowl and a wide, thick, generously chamfered stem. The silversmith must have used a blank at least 5 mm thick. Jean Redard is known to have produced some very fine and original pieces of silverware (tea caddy, spice box, marabout teapot, mustard pot, etc.).-----o Maker's mark IR on a clover [de Vevey p.197, no. 1300a; Junier Clerc & Krenz p.71 no. MAH 75a] o Town hallmark (eagle centered on the shield with three chevrons) [of Vevey p.197 no. 1300A; Junier Clerc & Krenz p.59 no. 23] Later monogram engraved on the spatula ----- Literature o Caroline Junier Clerc
