In his left hand, the figure holds the globe surmounted by a cross, a symbol of divine sovereignty and world order. The draperies are flowing and flowing. The careful modeling of the face and the quality of the carving attest to accomplished craftsmanship. Signs of age and use, wear and occasional losses of polychromy, restorations.
