This is a glazed and painted majolica flask, dating back to the 17th century, from southern or central Italy. This type is often identified as a "pilgrim's flask" (or "traveler's flask") due to the side handles that allowed it to be tied with strings for carrying. Item Details: Material: Glazed and polychrome painted terracotta. Period: 17th century. Origin: Southern or central Italy (e.g., Sicily, Caltagirone, or the Abruzzo/Romagna area). Decoration: Characterized by stylized floral motifs, with large yellow flowers and green leaves and stems on a white background, a typical and popular decoration of the period. H 40 cm W 28 cm.
