While it is undoubtedly her roses that have so deservedly secured her reputation, she excelled in depicting all kinds of flowers, as can be seen in the excellent works of Monique Pujo-Monfran or by visiting the Salies Museum in Bagnères-de-Bigorre. Quintessential winter flowers, these charming bouquets of violets are accompanied in their basket by branches of mimosa, some of whose yellow pom-poms have fallen onto the table...
