Standing at a remarkable 120 cm tall, these vases immediately impress with their extraordinary proportions, rarely seen for this type of object. Their sculptural presence lends the ensemble a truly architectural dimension, worthy of the grandest state decorations. Each side is adorned with medallions depicting landscapes and gallant scenes, finely printed and then delicately enhanced with painted highlights, evoking the pastoral and poetic aesthetic of the 18th century. between the depth of the blue porcelain and the softness of the figurative scenes creates a visually striking and elegant balance. The understated yet architecturally refined gilt-bronze mount accentuates the lines of the vase without ever weighing them down, lending structure and nobility to the whole. The side handles and molded bases reinforce the monumentality and harmony of the composition. Due to their exceptional dimensions, decorative quality, and rarity on the market, these vases are more akin to prestige objects than mere ornamental pieces.
