Description

Camille Fauré, Limoges enamel vase with floral decoration. Superb small globular vase (11 cm high), with a narrow neck encircled in copper, resting on a metal pedestal. It is decorated with a polychrome floral motif executed in Limoges enamel in low relief, on a nuanced iridescent background (greens, golds, pinks). Art Deco period, 1925-1935. Condition: superb. Camille Fauré (1874-1956) is one of the most celebrated enamellers of the Art Deco era; he was among the most innovative designers of his time. Today, his highly sought-after vases are featured in museum collections worldwide, notably at the Victoria and Albert Museum (London) and the Corning Museum of Glass (New York).
