




## Academy Of Man, School Of Fine Arts 1878

### Description

Male Academy Study, oil on canvas, awarded a prize in 1878. Very good condition. Dimensions with frame: 88 x 49 cm. A fine academy study of a nude male seen from behind, holding a baguette resting on his shoulder, in a classic studio pose. The body is rendered with precision and restraint, in the spirit of late 19th-century academic teaching: precise drawing, soft light, and a neutral background that highlight the volumes and anatomy. The plaque inscribed "École des Beaux-Arts - Year 1878 - 1st Prize - Gustave Rouault" most likely indicates a work created or awarded a prize as part of a studio or school competition, rather than by a famous artist, which is consistent with the very nature of this painting, originally intended for educational purposes. The painting is in very good condition, and its period
