A pair of large, three-light wall sconces in solid carved and patinated mahogany, Italy, circa 1850. The set features finely carved decoration, typical of mid-19th-century Italian production. Each mirror has three lights. Rewired for modern use. In very good condition, with a beautiful original patina.
