Description

Revernay stoneware. Large glazed stoneware vase with a stenciled floral design. The production of the "Revernay" line in Digoin differs from the usual production in large ceramic centers where quantity is a key factor in reducing production costs. Revernay stoneware pieces are among the creations of art workshops within the industry. The marks are handwritten, incised with a hard point into the clay before firing: - Revernay - 161 (shape number) - 47 (decoration number) Height - 37 cm. Digoin, a branch of Sarreguemines, the factory plans were drawn up in 1876, ceramic production began around 1879, the stoneware production around 1890.
