An exceptional and very rare cylinder desk, also known as a clock desk, made during the Napoleon III period in the refined Louis XV style. This exceptional piece is distinguished by the presence of a clock integrated into the cylinder, a spectacular and uncommon feature, giving the piece a character that is both decorative and functional. The structure is richly adorned with fine marquetry in precious woods, with elegant and perfectly balanced motifs, enhanced by finely chased gilt bronze ornamentation: feet, mounts, frames, and decorative elements of exceptional quality. The cylinder opens to reveal a compartmentalized interior with niches, drawers, and a writing
