A very important carved wooden mirror, dating from the 19th century, Napoleon III period, remarkable for the richness and quality of its decoration. The frame, finely carved with scrolls and volutes, is surmounted by an expressive central mascaron, typical of the historicist taste of the second half of the 19th century. The uprights and lower rail are also adorned with foliate motifs and scrolls, offering a balanced and highly decorative composition. The warm patina of the wood highlights the relief of the carvings and gives the whole an authentic and elegant character. The large mirror brings depth and light to both classic and contemporary interiors.
