



I present here an interesting bibliophilic rarity in two folio volumes, 1737 and 1739 for the second part, unique pieces on this beautiful city in the south of France, illustrated with folding maps; in two folio volumes bound in full mottled blond calfskin, spines with raised bands decorated with gilt fillets, titles and volume numbers in red and olive black parchment, two-color titles, pink speckled edges; Printed in Montpellier, by Jean Martel, Printer to the King and to Our Lords of the Estates General of the Province of Languedoc. 1737.
