Description

In keeping with the tradition of Hanami, this Sage Jubaku transport box with a handle on top and from the Edo period is composed of: - Transport box (h 31 cm, l 32 cm, w 19 cm) to be restored - Jubako box with 4 tiers (h 22 cm, l 19.5 cm x w 18.5 cm) in perfect condition, used for transporting meals. Decoration of flying cranes above traditional Japanese houses, gold lacquer, black, gold glitter - a tray (19.5 cm x 18.5 cm) and a sake cup (10 cm diameter), small - 2 rectangular compartments (2 x 10 cm x 18.5 cm), perfect condition - a stand for two tokkuri (10 cm x 18.5 cm) . Symbol of a cultural ritual rooted in the rhythm of the seasons, both functional and aesthetic, very beautiful and refined decoration, gold lacquer, red interior, cranes, cherry trees, chrysanthemums, traditional houses.
