Description

An elegant female bust entitled Manon, created by the sculptor Georges Trinqué, a French artist active in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, known for his gentle and poetic female figures. This work depicts a young woman with a delicate and serene face, slightly inclined, with a subtly smiling expression. The stylized, wavy hair, rendered with finesse, is fully in keeping with the Art Nouveau aesthetic, favoring flowing lines and harmonious forms. The sculpture is made of patinated terracotta, a material frequently used by Georges Trinqué for his decorative busts, intended for both bourgeois interiors and art lovers of his time. The name "MANON" is inscribed on the base, referring to an idealized female figure, very much in vogue in the artistic imagination of the Belle Époque. A decorative
