The sculpture depicts Guanyin (Sanskrit: Bodhisattva Avalokitesvara). It is made of bronze, with traces of gilding. Guanyin is a bodhisattva embodying compassion; his name means "to observe sounds," that is, to listen to requests. With his right hand, he makes the Vitarka Mudra gesture, the gesture of teaching. His left hand holds a vase containing nectar or a similar object, which is associated with compassion and the salvation of suffering people. China, Qing Dynasty (1644-1912). Height 19.5 cm, width 15 cm, depth 12.8 cm. Relatively good condition, with traces of corrosion and residual gilding. Free shipping within the European Union!
