A beautiful, antique work tool: a double-function hammer whose origin and exact purpose are unknown. It may have been used by a stonemason or bricklayer, likely in the Occitanie, Auvergne, or Limousin regions, for dry stone walling. The head is hand-forged, and the handle, made of serviceberry or cherry wood, is covered in leather, as is the leather binding. Dating it to the late 19th century is a conservative estimate, suggesting a professional, not decorative, use.
