A true example of 18th-century cabinetmaking, dating from the Louis XV period, this piece is of exceptional quality and was crafted around 1760. The cabinet is fully demountable; Liège furniture is renowned for its exquisite craftsmanship and high-quality joinery. This cabinet is in its original condition, requiring minimal restoration, although the clock mechanism should be serviced by a clockmaker. Excellent quality piece of furniture !
