Giant model of the "Caisse Fraternelle de Capitalisation." In French, this means "Caisse Fraternelle de Capitalisation," a large insurance company. The Caisse Fraternelle de Capitalisation, originally founded in 1913 in Lille, merged in 1977 with Gan Capitalisation. Gan is now part of the Groupama insurance group. This building is located at 6-8, rue Léon Trulin in Lille, France. The model is large and in very good condition. It is made from a type of plastic and wood and is hollow inside. We hesitate to give its exact age, but it probably dates back to at least the mid-20th century.
