feature swastika motifs (the Sanskrit word for "good fortune" or "well-being"). The motif, a crocheted cross, appears to have first been used in Eurasia 7,000 years ago, perhaps to represent the sun's movement throughout the day. The precise framing of the design highlights the quality of the craftsmanship. The subtle variations in wool and color, characteristic of hand-knitted rugs, confirm the authenticity of this antique piece and enhance its unique character. Both decorative and timeless, this Peking rug is a choice piece for an elegant interior, whether classic or contemporary.
