Hungary, mid-20th century Refined hand-painted white porcelain chocolate pot, produced by the renowned Herend Manufactory and dating to the mid-20th century. The body is decorated with a naturalistic scene featuring polychrome birds perched on flowering branches, enhanced by colorful butterflies delicately scattered across the surface. This decoration, characteristic of the Herend repertoire inspired by Central European tradition, displays remarkable painterly precision and vibrant colors. The shaped spout and elegantly curved handle are enriched with hand-applied gilt detailing and ornamental motifs. The domed lid is topped with a relief floral bud finial, a distinctive decorative element, also hand-painted. A triangular pouring opening, highlighted with gilt, is present. A fine-quality piece, ideal for collectors
