The spout is finely crafted in the shape of a bird's head, lending a strong decorative character to the piece. The curved, ergonomic handle in blackened wood offers an elegant contrast to the metal body. The lid is surmounted by a decorative finial, the whole piece being highlighted by chased friezes and raised details characteristic of 19th-century silversmithing. It has a beautiful patina consistent with age, without detracting from its presentation or stability. A striking decorative object, ideal for a display case, a classic or eclectic interior, or to complement a collection of antique tableware.
