Description

A small, curved sideboard in molded natural wood, opening with two doors with shaped panels, resting on a plinth base that follows the undulating lines of the piece. A French work from the 18th century, of provincial character, it displays fine proportions and an elegant silhouette with continuous curves, including on the sides. The front is enlivened by simple, well-defined moldings, typical of 18th-century domestic furniture. The piece retains a warm, antique patina, revealing its use and the passage of time without obscuring the clarity of its lines. The top and interior have been altered and modified in the past, probably in the 19th century, to adapt the piece for more functional use. These interventions, common on this type of furniture, respect the overall structure and attest to its

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history and longevity. A healthy and stable sideboard, offering a compact format that is easy to integrate into various interiors, both old and contemporary. The particularly balanced proportions and the curved line on all sides give this sideboard a marked decorative presence, rarely found on provincial models of this size.
