Oval plaque in white porcelain biscuit depicting King HENRY IV in bust form, facing right. The sovereign is recognizable by his long, wavy hair held back by a ribbon, his proud bearing, and the elegance of his drapery. The biscuit bust stands out against a blue background, creating a contrast that highlights the matte whiteness of the biscuit. The whole is framed by a finely molded gilt bronze border decorated with concentric striations. The plaque is presented in a giltwood frame, richly carved with scrolling foliage and foliate motifs, with partially patinated antique gilding. It is mounted on a background of light-colored wild silk, whose irregular and vibrant texture contributes to the elegance and preciousness of the presentation.
