design, this table offers great versatility: o as a dining table, it allows for an elegant and solemn setting; o as a console table, it structures a space with authority; o as a center table, it finds its perfect place in a hotel lobby, a prestigious entrance, or a reception area. It would be equally suited to a beautiful Parisian apartment, where it would naturally complement Haussmannian or classical architecture, as to a hotel entrance, used as a central table or monumental console table. It is ideally suited for displaying gilt bronze candlesticks or candelabra, allowing for a composition worthy of the grand taste of the 19th century.

Condition Report: o Some scratches from use o Some sun damage o Slight variations in patina, consistent with the age of the piece. A visit to a cabinetmaker is recommended for aesthetic restoration. We can undertake this work, with the cost remaining the responsibility of the final buyer, at an additional cost. We work with top-tier cabinetmakers and recommend a waxed finish, the most respectful solution for the wood and the spirit of the period. French polishing is also an option.
