Modernist office chair / armchair made around 1930, seat and back in laminated and thermoformed plywood, frame and legs in screwed chromed steel. Possibly a prototype. The tubular steel assembly is most likely from the 1930s, reminiscent of the style of Marcel Breuer's Wassily chair. Beautiful original condition, very stable, plywood also in good condition. In the Bauhaus style (Gerit Rietveld, Anton Lorenz, Herbert Bayer, Mart Stam), produced by L. & C. Arnold, Thonet, Marcel Breuer Metallmöbel, Standard-Möbel...
