Description

A beautiful small antique earthenware tureen from the Gien factory, "Thistles" pattern, Belle Époque, late 19th/early 20th century, circa 1890-1910. It features a dark blue printed decoration of stylized thistles. The earthenware is a slightly creamy ivory white, characteristic of Gien's opaque porcelain. The tureen is complete with its original lid, which has a charming handle. The side handles are in the same style. The decoration on the lid is slightly darker than that on the body, a common difference on antique pieces, due to separate firings or baths. It is marked underneath with the factory's coat of arms: "Porcelaine Opaque de Gien - Chardons" (Gien Opaque Porcelain - Thistles).
