### Description

Elegant pair of decorative friezes dating from the mid-18th century, finely carved in wood and gilded with pure gold leaf. The friezes depict winged putti heads, modelled with great sculptural sensitivity and set within a lively and harmonious composition, enriched with scrolls and foliate motifs typical of the late Baroque / early Rococo style. The original gilding, applied with traditional techniques, retains a warm golden tone and a coherent aged patina, enhancing the depth and details of the carving. The quality of execution suggests an Italian origin, likely intended for architectural decoration or for the embellishment of fine frames or mirrors. Highly decorative and charming objects, ideal for enhancing boiserie panels, overdoor decorations, mirrors or a collection of 18th-century giltwood
