Description

Bas-relief depicting a sower, early 18th century. Carved and formerly gilded wooden bas-relief depicting a sower. It may be an allegory of spring. The central register is surrounded by stylized plant motifs: scrolls, trellises, small flowers, etc. Visible losses and damage. Two wall sconces clearly from the same series--same size, same decoration--are in the Fitzwilliam Museum, Cambridge ("wall sconces" M.32A-1961 and M.32B-1961) and depict other agricultural scenes. Height: 63 cm - Width: 31 cm. First third of the 18th century.
