Saucer diameter: 13 cm Saucer height: 3 cm Cup height: 6.2 cm Cup diameter: 9 cm Introduced in the 18th century, the porcelains of the rose family carry polychrome decorations in which pink tones dominate. The decor is placed on covered, that is to say after a first firing of the porcelain covered with transparent enamel. This is a Western classification of porcelain from the Qing dynasty, known in Chinese under different terms: fencai, ruancai, yangcai and falangcai.
