Oil on copper. Exquisite technique. Frans Snyders' still lifes represent the pinnacle of Flemish Baroque, where the still life genre breaks free from its traditional static nature to explode into a vibrant and sensual opulence. In his compositions, hunting tables and marketplaces are transformed into scenes of absolute sensory drama, where the accumulation of delicacies, fruits with almost palpable textures, and game is arranged under dramatic lighting that accentuates their exuberance. Far from monastic tranquility, Snyders introduces a kinetic energy by including live animals--hungry dogs, furtive cats, or exotic birds--which, through their interaction with the feast, lend the work a theatrical rhythm and a singular narrative tension. His touch, of superb technical mastery, does not merely depict the
