Description

Andrea Michieli, known as Vicentino (Vicenza 1524, Venice 1618). Oil on canvas depicting "Moses Saved from the Waters." This work, profoundly influenced by the style of the master Paolo Veronese, bears a seal on the back with a double-headed eagle, certifying its provenance from a 19th-century Austro-Hungarian collection. The depth of the scene, combined with the skillful composition of the figures, lends the overall effect an elegant depth of perspective and a richness of color, transforming this biblical scene into an almost surreal painting. This work can be considered one of Michieli's masterpieces and undoubtedly reflects the strong personality acquired by his master, Paolo Veronese.
