### Description

Elegant Rococo frieze dating from the early 18th century, finely carved in wood and gilded with pure gold leaf, an outstanding example of the refined craftsmanship characteristic of the early rocaille period. The composition displays a strong sense of movement and harmony, enriched by luxuriant floral and vegetal motifs carved in high relief. Flowing scrolls and stylized flowers intertwine in a balanced and dynamic arrangement. The carving is deep and finely executed, enhancing the original gilding, which remains bright and visually striking. The frieze retains a beautiful aged patina, attesting to its authenticity and historical character. A decorative object of great visual impact, suitable both as an independent wall ornament and as an elegant addition to a classic interior or an antique.
