Description

The Water Lily Fairy, bronze cup by Maurice Bouval. A student of Falguière, Maurice Bouval was a sculptor active between the 1880s and World War I. Renowned for his delicate bronzes and decorative objects, he was a member of the Société des Artistes Français and participated in the 1900 World's Fair. His work is characteristic of Art Nouveau, where the female figure and inspiration from nature occupy a central place. The work we are presenting, Coupe à la fée au nénuphar (Cup with Fairy and Water Lily), perfectly illustrates the artist's refinement and poetry. A delicately sculpted fairy in bas-relief rests in the heart of a water lily, whose stem serves as an elegant handle for the object. This cup combines harmony between aesthetics and functionality, perfectly embodying the spirit of
