Iranian wool rug, cotton warp and weft, circa 1980. Very good condition. The Afchar people, an ancient nomadic population of Eastern Armenia (eastern Turkey) and Iranian Azerbaijan, are located in Khorasan (northeast Iran), the southern Kerman region (southern Iran), and Fars (southwest Iran). This Afchar rug from the Kerman region was woven by Afchar people from the Shahre Babak area. Birds perched in trees stand out against a navy blue background, surrounded by a multitude of göls (flowers). A border with a naive motif on a red background highlights the central design.
