Antique frame, giltwood (signs of wear). Frame dimensions: 72 x 56 cm. Drawing dimensions: 58 x 43 cm. Signed. Romain Malfliet (Saint-Nicolas-Waas, 1910-2006). Painter, watercolorist, engraver. Trained at the Academy of Sint-Niklaas, the Academy of Ghent, and the Higher Institute of Antwerp. Student of J. De Bruycker, W. Vaes, and Is. Opsomer. Member of the Kringen Pictura and the Koninklijke Wase Kunstkring. In 1979, the book "Hommage Romain Malfliet en het Land van Waas" was published, featuring nearly three hundred engravings. He was a professor of graphic design at the Academy of Sint-Niklaas (1951-1975) and taught at the academies of Temse and Hemiksem.
