Jakub Zucker 1900 - 1981 Poland - NY,
Ashkenazi Israeli painter * It seems to me that
this is the Jaffa Synagogue in 1946. The Libyan
Synagogue of Jaffa (Beit HaKnesset Le'olei Lub),
located on Mazal Daggim Street in the Old City,
is the oldest synagogue in Tel Aviv-Jaffa.

Founded in 1948 in a former hotel by Jewish
immigrants from Libya, it is still in operation.

This historic place is renowned for its arched
architecture and communal atmosphere.

Description: A moment of serenity in prayer, in
search of Yahweh. The red staircase, drawn in a
zigzag pattern, makes the scene original in the
spirit of Matisse. Condition: Original oil on
canvas, nothing to do, impeccable condition, but
no frame. ** Signature: Signed in Hebrew and
dated in the upper right corner, 46 for 1946.
