The Raising of the Cross by Rembrandt Harmenszoon van Rijn, mirror image, 17th century, after. This painting represents Rembrandt's work entitled "The Raising of the Cross." It illustrates the moment when Jesus is crucified by Roman soldiers. Rembrandt painted it in 1633, and it is currently housed in the Alte Pinakothek in Munich. The theme of "The Raising of the Cross" was popular in Baroque art. Another famous triptych of the same name is signed Peter Paul Rubens. One of the symbols present in Rembrandt's painting is a dog which, in Flemish culture, symbolizes fidelity and could represent faith in the Resurrection of Christ. Highly decorative.
