A rare and elegant pair of three-arm wall sconces in finely chased and gilded bronze, made in the 19th century in the pure spirit of the Louis XVI style. Each sconce features a richly worked ribbon bow at the top, an emblematic motif of the Louis XVI repertoire, extended by a fluted stem adorned with a foliate sheaf. The three harmoniously curved arms are decorated with molded bobeches and demonstrate meticulous and balanced chasing. The original gilding, luminous and well-preserved, has a beautiful warm patina, highlighting the quality of the bronze and the finesse of the decorative details. The set is in very good condition. Wiring is present. With their elegance and balanced proportions, these sconces integrate perfectly into a classic or Haussmannian interior, but also into a
