FRENCH SCHOOL, mid-19th century. Young woman crowned with laurel, Allegory. Graphite drawing. Speckled maple frame with glass. Dimensions: H. 47 cm, W. 34 cm. Dimensions with frame: H. 63.5 cm, W. 46 cm. Slight fading. This drawing, probably from the mid 19th century, depicts an allegory personified by a charming young woman crowned with a laurel wreath. Represented in profile, half-length, the model is ideally rendered, her gaze lost in the distance. Her noble features - her aquiline nose, full lips, and defined eyebrows - are finely sketched. The interplay of light and shadow lends modeling and relief to the details of the face as well as to the background of the composition.
