It bears the cold-stamped markings: "TREBLE" (surmounted by the lyre logo) and "ENGLAND". Details and mechanisms: o Mechanism: Retractable solid brass rewinding crank, smooth and perfectly functional. o Tape: Original reinforced textile (linen) tape, with a brass pull end. o Capacity: 10 meters (marked "10M" on the crank hub). Condition: Excellent collector's condition. The leather is sound, the stitching is well preserved. The brass has a beautiful natural oxidation that
