? Two suspended lights, timeless. Like two silent presences, these 1960s opaline pendant lights seem to float in space. Their white glass diffuses a soft, almost milky light that soothes the atmosphere and gently highlights the room's dimensions. The lampshades are original, carefully preserved and reinterpreted with a completely new frame, designed for contemporary use. The generous cable length offers great freedom: they truly shine in a room with high ceilings, or suspended low, above a table or island, where they become genuine decorative elements. One of the two opaline shades has a crack on the top--visible only when viewed from above. A discreet trace of time, invisible once in use, which does not alter either the visual balance or the quality of the light. ?
