Elegant pair of Directoire-style armchairs, of probable Northern Italian origin, crafted in solid walnut and datable to the early 19th century, reflecting the transition toward the Empire taste. The armchairs display a well-balanced and harmonious structure, featuring sabre-shaped legs at both the front and rear, typical of the period, and shaped armrests enriched with a refined flat scroll turning, sober and elegant, clearly inspired by Directoire design. The slightly reclined backs and generously proportioned seats ensure comfortable seating. The wooden structure is solid and stable, with well-preserved surfaces that highlight the natural grain of the walnut. The upholstery has been recently renewed, using a light-colored fabric decorated with subtle classical motifs; it is in excellent condition, clean
