Rare Set of Three Gothic Wall Sconces - Early 20th Century. An exceptional set of three antique wall sconces, carved from dense and finely worked pear wood. Each sconce represents a stylized bird, likely inspired by medieval bestiaries (griffin or fantastical bird), characteristic of the early 20th-century Neo-Gothic style. The birds hold in their beaks a four-sided tulip-shaped lantern, a stamped copper structure housing granulated yellow glass. When lit, these lanterns diffuse a warm, vibrant, and deeply atmospheric light, creating a spectacular, almost cinematic ambiance. The ensemble produces lighting of rare charm, ideal for: a period home, an architect's or decorator's project, or an unusual or intimate space such as a bar, restaurant, library, private mansion, or cultural
