Description

A beautiful oil on canvas signed by Édouard Bourgeois, known as Debourg, depicting a wooded landscape most likely in the Creuse or Limousin region. The composition is distinguished by a marked atmospheric quality, a beautiful depth of field, and a subtle handling of light, characteristics of artists associated with the Crozant School. The palette, dominated by nuanced greens, warm ochres, and luminous blues, reflects a sensitive observation of nature and the variations of light filtering through the foliage. The brushstrokes are confident, the paint applied with care, placing this work within a Post-Impressionist aesthetic. The painting is signed "Debourg" and presented in a

molded and gilded wooden frame, which elegantly enhances the composition. The gallery regularly acquires works by artists of the Crozant School. About the artist: Édouard Bourgeois, known as Debourg (1880-1939), was a French painter associated with the Crozant School. He belonged to the tradition of landscape painters of the Creuse Valley, developing a style attentive to nature, light, and changing atmospheres.
