A beautiful filigree silver cross, crafted using a traditional technique of twisted and openwork silver wire, testifies to meticulous and entirely handmade goldsmithing. The exquisitely delicate composition is organized around a central floral motif in relief, surrounded by regular scrolls and spirals, characteristic of filigree work from the late 19th and very early 20th centuries. The style and quality of execution suggest that this piece is likely from the Iberian Peninsula (Portugal or northern Spain), regions renowned for their exquisitely delicate religious filigree jewelry. The cross maintains a beautiful balance of proportions and an elegant visual lightness, while also possessing a solid structure.
