Description

An elegant vintage brooch in clear plexiglass, with a faceted polygonal shape, adorned with a stylized floral design engraved in relief. The composition features a bouquet of geometric flowers with finely sculpted petals, arranged in a rosette, accompanied by minimalist foliage. The highly precise engraving creates subtle plays of light and depth, enhancing the piece's graphic appeal. The brooch's strong geometric form, combined with its metal pin fastening, is characteristic of the Art Deco aesthetic, a movement that favored clean lines, structured volumes, and the innovative use of modern materials. Plexiglass, an emblematic material of the 1930s and 40s in costume jewelry, is used here with refinement, offering an elegant contrast between the transparency of the material and the

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frosted floral motifs. A decorative and luminous piece, typical of Art Deco jewelry, appreciated by both collectors and lovers of graphic and timeless jewelry.
