### Description

Pair of busts representing Seneca and Socrates. Patinated plaster - Early 20th century. A beautiful pair of busts depicting the ancient philosophers Seneca and Socrates, made of patinated plaster in the early 20th century, in the academic tradition inspired by Greco-Roman antiquity. The bust of Socrates is distinguished by a powerful and expressive face: abundant hair, a full beard, and a deep, slightly haunted gaze, forcefully conveying the classical iconography of the Greek philosopher, a symbol of critical thinking and the quest for truth. The bust of Seneca, more restrained and hieratic, presents a face with firm, thoughtful features, his gaze directed towards the horizon. The drapery, held by a circular fibula, reinforces the Stoic dignity and moral authority associated with the famous Roman philosopher
