Relic of Saint Eleutherius - 19th Century -

Belgium. Authentic oval reliquary in gilt brass, mounted as a pendant, containing an authentic relic of Saint Eleutherius (Sti Eleutheri Ep. Corn.).

Description: The front features a carefully crafted decoration on a light textile background, adorned with metal wires arranged in a radial pattern. In the center, the relic is set within a circular gilt metal mount with openwork decoration, typical of the 18th century. Two contemporary handwritten labels precisely identify the relic: o In the upper part: "Et Oss." (abbreviation of Ex Ossibus = bone fragment) o In the lower part: "Sti Eleutheri Ep. Corn." -> Saint Eleutherius, bishop and martyr of Corinth.

Reverse: The back is sealed with old reddish-brown wax, applied to a pinkish textile
