The elements are sculptural and the arrangement follows a specific abstract geometry. The natural materials exert an attractive visual appeal. (New professional framing in matte black) His works are two-dimensional assemblages that combine natural materials such as minerals (marble, limestone, slate), plants (wood, rope, bamboo, coconut fibers, jute) and animal elements such as leather. They represent records of his life journey, his travels, records of his thoughts and feelings. Jean-Paul Chablais, born in 1952, is a French painter and sculptor. He works in France, the Czech Republic, Australia, North and South
