The supple and delicate watercolor brushstrokes subtly capture the reflections on the water, the nuances of the sky, and the harmony of tones, demonstrating the skill of this artist, renowned for his maritime and harbor views. This type of subject is typical of Henri Callot's work, as he frequently painted the oyster farming landscapes and ports of the Charente coast, particularly the Île de Ré and Île d'Oléron.
